### **Siloam Mission Update**

Siloam Mission has ordered more beds for its on-site emergency shelter to accommodate the growing number of homeless lining up outside its building each evening seeking a warm, safe place to sleep.

Hannah's Place Emergency Shelter, located on the second floor of Siloam Mission's 300 Princess Street location, currently has 73 beds available for men and women and five beds available in its family room. The additional beds on order will allow it to be at capacity – at 105 beds.

Siloam Mission's Chief Executive Officer John Mohan says, "As the weather becomes colder, the need for warm shelter becomes greater. Providing this service to Winnipeg's homeless is about providing a place of safety, rest, and especially warmth. It's about alleviating the hardships of homelessness while also making Winnipeg a better city for all of us."

Siloam Mission continues to expand its services, currently offering meals and clothing, an expressive arts program, computer training, a book literacy program, an employment training program called MOST (Mission: Off the Street Team), an emergency shelter and a health care centre.
